

Handbook on ICT in Developing Countries: 5G Perspective

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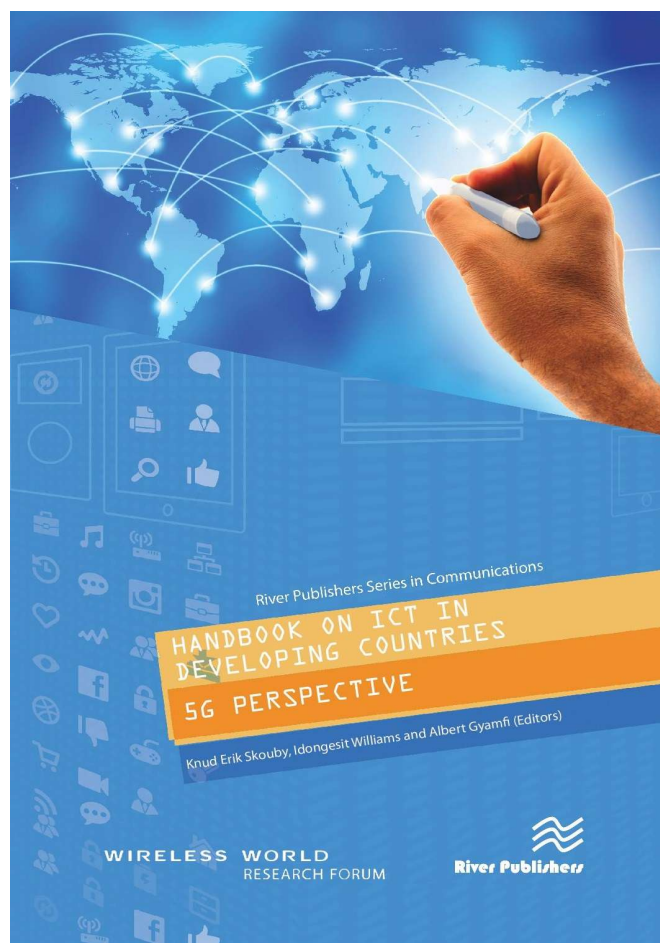
